This is how I came into contact with people in Malawi outside the beaten roads where small farmers built a piece of land. Usually with corn as a staple food for your own use. Because of the poor look, the first thing that came to mind was 'this never becomes something'. I took notes about my observations and later worked them out substantiated to be able to use as a reference book. I soon gained an understanding of the traditional farming method from father to son that, despite the lack of background knowledge, was largely compensated by experience...

My personal situation did not lend itself to returning in recent years. As a farmer's son and with my experiences I could easily have helped a season and learned from it. It could have been done by setting other priorities. Now it is no longer possible because of my physical condition and I am sorry...

The contribution is intended to inform everyone who wants or needs to know that Malawian society will continue to live hopelessly in poverty due to lack of resources and possibilities with the knowledge of the water-headed government...
